I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend funds totaling Seven Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars (\$792,669.00) from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety and Security to the City of Boston's Police Department, Boston Regional Intelligence Center (BRIC). Funds will be used by the BRIC to upgrade, expand and integrate technology and protocols related to anti-terrorism, anti-crime, anti-gang and emergency response. All intelligence gleaned will be shared with local, State and Federal partners to enhance efficiencies for mitigating safety and security threats.

I urge your Honorable Body to adopt this Order as soon as possible so that the City of Boston may accept the funds expeditiously and expend them for the purposes for which these funds were granted.
